



Beginners are welcome, and anyone whose been at this a while is encouraged to bring their forging or welding problems for help getting solutions. The intent




is a small group atmosphere with the student leaving with something in their hand that they have done. For example: most everyone in the damascus welding group left with a completed billet and a forged blade last year.


